



# VISUAL PERFORMANCE INDIVIDUAL

**Utilize this placemat as a reference for philosophy and as a tool for comparison.**

The goal of the Visual Performance Individual Sheet is to reward the **Skill and Training** of the individual performers, as it relates to accuracy and definition and the quality of technique. Provide a representative sampling and evaluation of the individual performance considering the content responsibilities required of the performers through the “active demonstration” of skill in form, body and equipment.

The tape commentary should provide accountability for evaluation, constructive criticism, and useful information that encourages improvement. Additionally, the tenor of the commentary should be genuine helpfulness and geared for student listening.

## ACCURACY AND DEFINITION CONSIDERATIONS

Which unit had greater success:

- establishing technique and range in effort changes?
- establishing the principles of movement?
- demonstrating the quality of spatial pathways in body articulation and equipment?
- achieving consistency with the responsibilities given to the individual?
- demonstrating a range of responsibilities layered in form, body and/or equipment?
- demonstrating compatibility between the performer and the responsibilities?
- dealing with challenges of space in form and line?
- controlling the fundamentals of form and equipment?
- controlling tempo, rhythmic variations, or phrases without tempo, and pulse?

## QUALITY OF TECHNIQUE CONSIDERATIONS

Which unit had the greater success:

- demonstrating a well-developed articulation with respect to time in body and equipment?
- displaying poise in movement and equipment?
- attending to both mental and physical recovery?
- displaying quality technique in handling auxiliary equipment?
- demonstrating a clearly defined and refined style from the individuals?
- defining footwork for any and all situations?
- displaying variety, range and uniformity in technique?
- demonstrating detail and nuance in individual technique?
- demonstrating a high level of training and an effortless display of technique?
